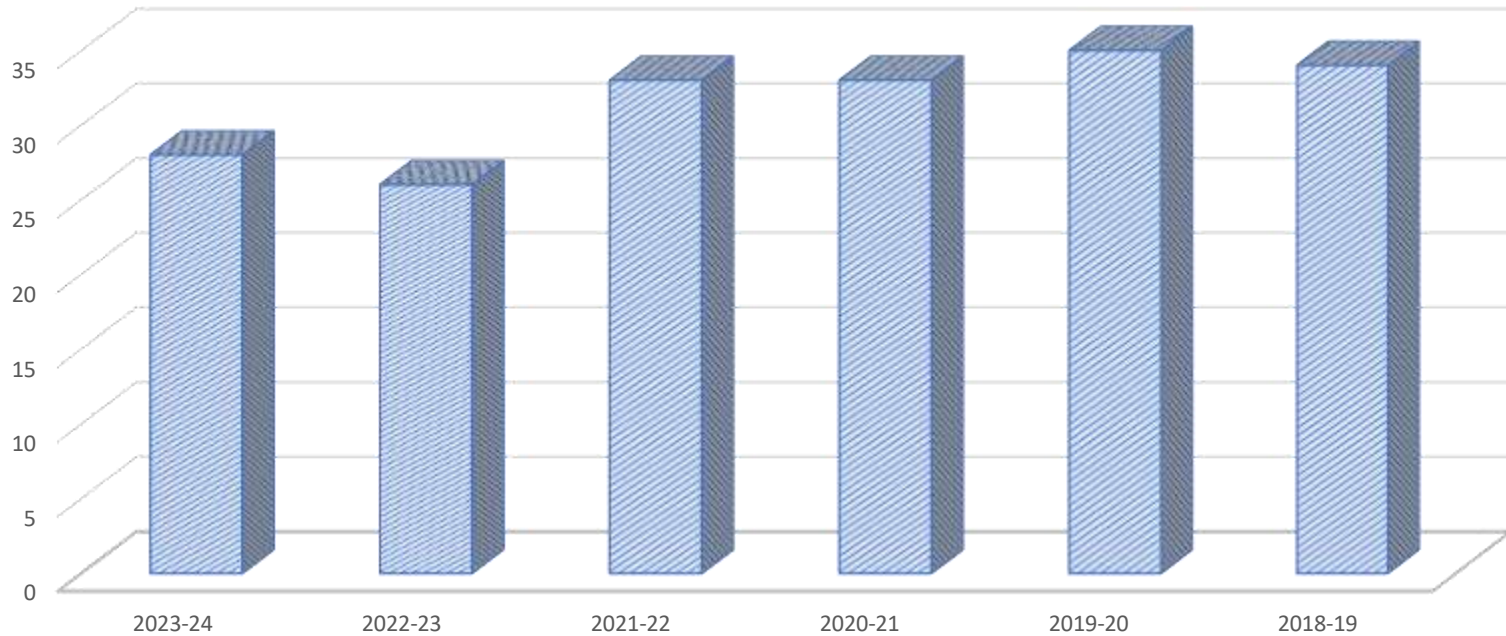

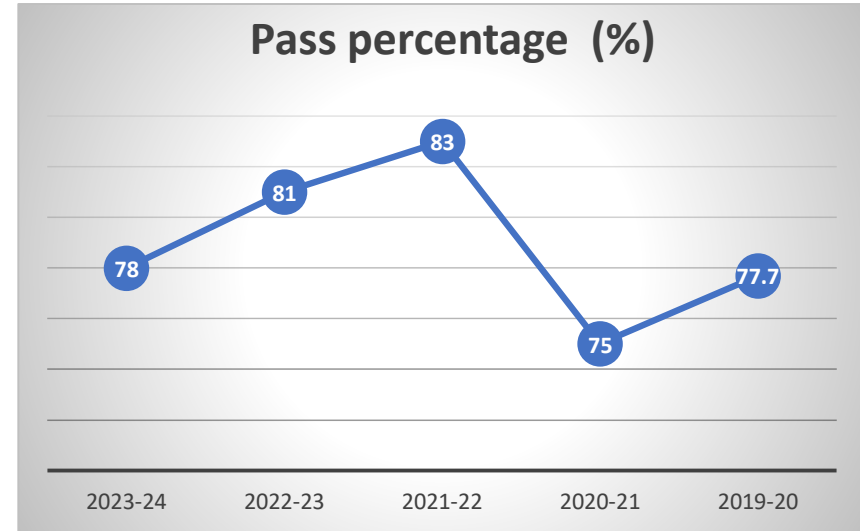
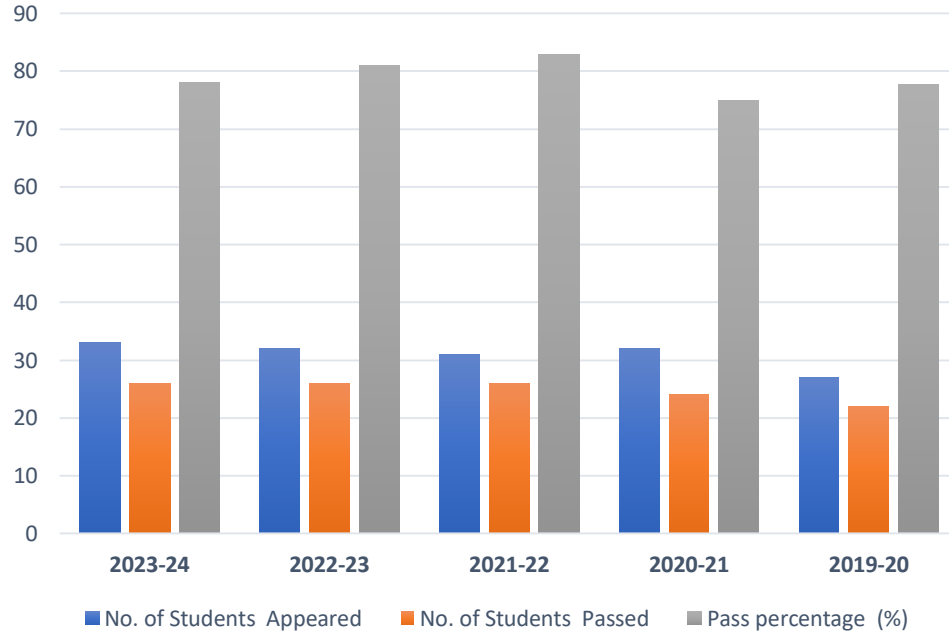

Best Performer of Last Five Years

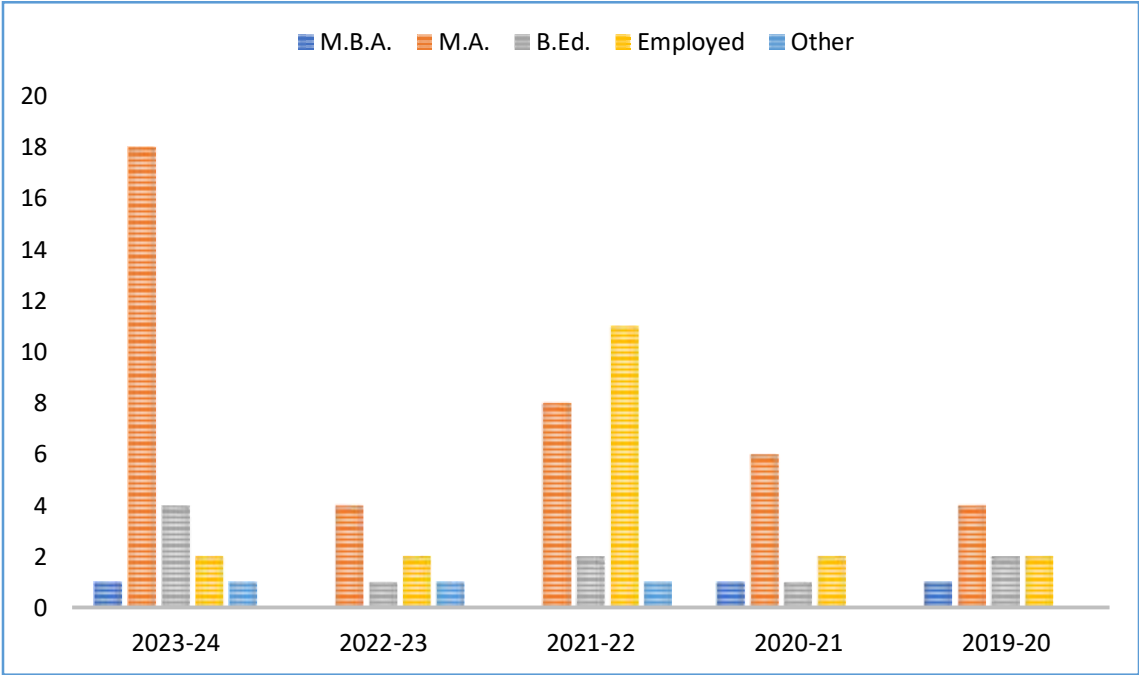
