

The college decides take a feedback on the currentsyllabi from the parents. About 300feedback was collected from

the parents from each department. The data we recollected with the help of a structure dquest i on naire.

Responses received from the parents are presented in Fig. -3.

Morethan95% of the respondents positively responded that the syllabic ontained a statement of objectives, the contents of the syllabi matched their child's academic interent / amptitude and the curriculum would provide job opportunities to their wards.

More than 88% of the students responded that the syllabus

encouraged their child to go beyond it, the curriculum took their ward's academic and profess ional needs into account and they also discussed the relevance of syllabus with teachers.

However, 74% of the respondents felt that the syllabus needs revision.

About11% of the respondents felt that the topics in the syllabus we retoolimited / vast, where as 8% of the respondents complained about some aspects of the syllabi.
